



Economic Injury Disaster Loan Form – Required Forms to Attach

- This Application (SBA Form 5), completed and signed
- Complete copy of the organization's most recent tax return OR a copy of the organization's IRS tax-exempt certification and complete copies of the organization's three most recent years' "Statement of Activities"
- · Schedule of Liabilities
- Tax Information Authorization (IRS Form 4506-T), completed and signed for each applicant and for any affiliated entity
- They may request a current Year-To-Date Profit and Loss Statement

Considerations for Religious Employers

- Will applying for one of these loans require a religious employer to hire employees who are unwilling to subscribe to the organization's statement of faith or comply with its code of conduct? At issue is specific guidance relating to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act.
